



### Uniform Numbering Policy

This policy includes requirements for all platforms.

1. FIFA, US Club and UYSA Match Policy states, ‘The jersey must display a unique number on the back of the jersey.’
2. Players on each specific team MUST have a unique number, no duplicates
3. MLS Next AD, GA try to use 1-30 for designated players and save 31-35 for “guest players”
4. DAL, DPL try to use 1-30 for designated players and save 31-35 for players that may be club passing or “guest playing” with MLS Next AD or GA.
5. The Pre-Academy will be assigned numbers.

**Requests for a specific number, outside the defined range, will need to be approved.**

Any player choosing to play outside their age group is doing so at their own risk. You will be required to conform to the policy if you choose to move back to your age, thus resulting in a possible new uniform purchase. Any player multi-rostering must realize they are responsible for jersey coordination and may need to purchase additional jerseys.

Teams may purchase uniforms for guest players. Please keep the numbers ranges in mind when doing so.
